Pursuant to the requirements of Public Act 198 of 1974, as amended, the State Tax Commission (Commission) at their February 11, 2020 meeting, considered Application for Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption Certificate number 2013-460 filed by Paragon Metals, Inc., for a facility located at 282 Industrial Drive in the City of Hillsdale, Hillsdale County.

The Commission, at their February 11, 2020 meeting, denied this application based on MCL 207.565(6) as the application submitted on behalf of Paragon Metals, Inc doesn't meet the filing requirements to reinstate and transfer the certificate due to the applicant not being the subsequent owner.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer, or modification of this exemption may appeal the finding and order of the State Tax Commission to the Circuit Court, as provided by Public Act 306 of 1969, as amended.

Pursuant to the requirements of Public Act 198 of 1974, as amended, the State Tax Commission (Commission) at their February 11, 2020 meeting, considered Application for Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption Certificate number 2019-112 filed by Arnold Tool and Die Co., for a facility located at 48800 Structural Drive in the Chesterfield Charter Township, Macomb County.

The Commission, at their February 11, 2020 meeting, denied this application based on MCL 207.559(2)(c) as the commencement of the project occurred earlier than 6 months before the filing of the application.
