The State Tax Commission (Commission) has received a resolution from the City of Detroit regarding the revocation of Commercial Rehabilitation Certificate Number C2015-030, issued to Town Partners, located at Intersection Of Gratiot Avenue & Russell Street in the City of Detroit.

Public Act 210 of 2005, the Commercial Rehabilitation Act (Act), provides for the revocation of a certificate by the legislative body of the qualified local governmental unit. The Act does not require action by the Commission following the revocation by a qualified local governmental unit. However, the Commission acknowledges the revocation of Certificate number C2015-030 as approved by the City of Detroit and the resolution will be filed for future reference.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer or modification of an exemption may appeal a final decision by filing a petition with the Michigan Tax Tribunal, www.michigan.gov/taxtrib, within 35 days. MCL 205.735a (6).
