The State Tax Commission (Commission) has received a resolution from the City of Saginaw regarding the transfer of Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Certificate Number 3-18-0006, issued to Fifth Avenue Limited Partnership, located at 409 Adams in City of Saginaw.

Public Act 146 of 2000, the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Act (Act), provides for the transfer of a certificate by the legislative body of the qualified local governmental unit. The Act does not require action by the Commission following the transfer by a qualified local governmental unit. However, the Commission acknowledges the transfer of Certificate number 3-18-0006 as approved by the City of Saginaw and will change our records to reflect this transfer. The resolution will be filed for future reference.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer or modification of this exemption certificate may appeal a final decision by filing a petition with the Michigan Tax Tribunal, [www.michigan.gov/taxtrib](http://www.michigan.gov/taxtrib), within 35 days. MCL 205.735a (6).
