The State Tax Commission (Commission) has received a resolution from the City of Jackson regarding the revocation of Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Certificate Number 3-19-0030, issued to Bridgepoint Development LLC, located at 148 E Cortland And 134 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard in City of Jackson.

Public Act 146 of 2000, the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Act (Act), provides for the revocation of a certificate by the legislative body of the qualified local governmental unit. The Act does not require further action by the Commission following the revocation by a qualified local governmental unit. However, the Commission acknowledges the revocation of Certificate number 3-19-0030 as approved by the City of Jackson and the resolution will be placed in the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Number 3-19-0030 file for future reference.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer or modification of this exemption certificate may appeal a final decision by filing a petition with the Michigan Tax Tribunal, www.michigan.gov/taxtrib, within 35 days. MCL 205.735a (6).
