The State Tax Commission (Commission) has received a resolution from the City of Manistee regarding the revocation of Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Certificate Number 3-20-0029, issued to Stephen H. Glagola, located at 314 Sibben Street in City of Manistee.

Public Act 146 of 2000, the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Act (Act), provides for the revocation of a certificate by the legislative body of the qualified local governmental unit. The Act does not require further action by the Commission following the revocation by a qualified local governmental unit. However, the Commission acknowledges the revocation of Certificate Number 3-20-0029 as approved by the City of Manistee and the resolution will be placed in the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Number 3-20-0029 file for future reference.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer or modification of this exemption certificate may appeal a final decision by filing a petition with the Michigan Tax Tribunal, [www.michigan.gov/taxtrib](http://www.michigan.gov/taxtrib), within 35 days. MCL 205.735a (6).
