# Instructions for Completing Form 6052 Application for Solar Energy Facility Exemption Certificate

The Solar Energy Facility Exemption Certificate was created by 2023 Public Act 108, as amended. The application is filed, reviewed, and approved by the Local Governmental Unit (LGU) and then reviewed and approved by the State Tax Commission. According to Section 3 of 2023 Public Act 108, as amended, a Solar Energy District must be in place to qualify for the exemption.

## **Applicant Instructions**

- 1. Complete Parts 1, 2 and 3 of the application.
- 2. Prepare and attach all documents required under Part 2 of the application:
  - a. Parcel number(s) of the real property. List all relevant parcel numbers.
  - b. Legal description of the real property.
  - c. A statement describing the facility and the proposed project that must include all of the following items:
    - i. General description of the qualified facility;
    - ii. Proposed nameplate capacity (in megawatts);
    - iii. Itemized list of facility components, including any on-site battery storage;
    - iv. General description of the proposed use of the qualified facility;
    - v. A description of the general nature and extent of the new construction;
    - vi. A time schedule for undertaking and completing the qualified facility;
    - vii. The proposed location of the qualified facility on the property (include drawings if necessary).
  - d. Warranty deed or other proof of ownership.
  - e. For a leased qualified facility, a copy of the lease agreement or other writing confirming that the lessee is liable for payment of the specific tax for the length of the certificate, and proof of that liability.
  - f. For a qualified facility located on leased real property or an easement, a copy of the memorandum of lease or memorandum of easement, which must confirm that the duration of any lease of the real property where the qualified facility is located, including all options to extend the duration of the lease, is equal to or exceeds the duration of the certificate.
  - g. Provide a statement that the applicant agrees to provide to the qualified local governmental unit an annual form as of December 31 of each year indicating the nameplate capacity in alternating current of the qualified facility, including any additions to the facility or retirements from the facility of any equipment during that year, or any other reporting requirements the State Tax Commission determines is necessary.
  - h. Provide a copy of the resolution establishing the Solar Energy District (if applicable).
- 3. Submit the application and all attachments to the clerk of the LGU where the qualified facility will be located.

#### **LGU Assessor Instructions**

Complete and sign Part 4 of the application. Provide a reasonable estimate of what the assessed and taxable values of the property would be on the proposed facility if no exemption was granted. These values may be estimated using the facility components list provided by the applicant.

### **LGU Clerk Instructions**

- 1. After LGU action to either approve or deny the application, complete Part 5 of the application.
- 2. After reviewing the application for complete and accurate information, complete Part 6 and sign the application to certify the application meets the requirements as outlined by 2023 Public Act 108, as amended. Include the date the LGU received the application from the applicant in the box located at the top of page 1 of the application.
- 3. Assemble the following for a complete application:
  - a. Completed Application for Solar Energy Facility Exemption Certificate (Form 6052)
  - b. All required attachments listed under Part 2
  - c. A copy of the resolution by the LGU establishing the district (if applicable)
  - d. A certified copy of the resolution by the LGU approving the application
