REMINDER FOR MAY AND JULY FILING DEADLINES TRIBUNAL BIDS ADIEU TO BROOKE KITA MEMORIAL DAY OFFICE CLOSURE

May 31, 2022, and July 31, 2022 Filing Deadlines

Upcoming 2022 Filing Dates for Petitions; Tuesday, May 31st, filing deadline, and Monday, August 1st, for the July 31st deadline.

The Tribunal would like to remind property owners and/or their representatives that the May 31st appeal deadline is rapidly approaching. Tuesday, May 31, 2022, is the deadline for filing valuation appeals involving commercial real property, industrial real property, developmental real property, commercial personal property, industrial personal property, or utility personal property valuation appeals.

July 31, 2022, is a Sunday, thus August 1, 2022, is the deadline for filing 2022 petitions with the Tribunal for property classified as agricultural real property, residential real property, timber-cutover real property, or agricultural personal property.
