**SUBJECT:** Public Health Code Fees Annual Adjustments for Change in Detroit CPI

Four sections of the Public Health Code require that fee changes be based on amounts determined by the State Treasurer to reflect annual percent changes in the Detroit CPI. [The sections are: 333.5431(4), 333.13306(4), 333.13522(8) and 333.13104(8)].

The June 2018 Detroit CPI equaled 234.695; the June 2019 Detroit CPI-U equaled 234.895. Thus, the **percentage change from June 2018 to June 2019 in the Detroit CPI-U is +0.1 percent.**

**Newborn Screening Fee**

As stipulated in **MCL 333.5431(4)**: To reflect the 0.1 percent increase in the Detroit CPI between June 2018 and June 2019, the newborn screening fee may be increased by no more than \$0.13 from \$130.36 to \$130.49 on October 1, 2019. Please note that the newborn screening fee may be increased as recommended by the Newborn Screening Quality Advisory Committee and approved by the legislature to cover the cost of new screening requirements.

In addition, as provided under MCL 333.5430, the fee may also be adjusted to account for changes in conditions covered and screening procedures as recommended by the newborn screening quality assurance advisory committee subject to the approval of the Department of Community Health and the legislature.

**Dry Cleaning License Fees**

As stipulated under **MCL 333.13306**, dry cleaning management establishment fees shall increase for license year 2020 as follows:

- Initial application and annual license base fee increases \$0.18 from \$175.38 to \$175.56.
- Poundage fee remains unchanged at \$4.83.

**Radiation Machine Registration Fees and Mammography Authorization Fees**

As stipulated under **MCL 333.13522**, the following adjustments should be made effective October 1, 2019 to the fees:

- Nondental, nonveterinary x-ray tube:  
Per tube fee: \$0.13 increase from \$131.39 to \$131.52
- Dental or veterinary x-ray tube  
First tube fee: \$0.08 increase from \$78.81 to \$78.89  
Each additional tube fee \$0.04 increase from \$43.72 to \$43.76

*In connection with mammography authorization (per radiation machine)*

- Inspection fee: \$0.18 increase from \$175.23 to \$175.41
- Reinspection for re-instatement: \$0.18 increase from \$175.23 to \$175.41
- Evaluation for compliance: \$1.18 increase from \$1,177.70 to \$1,178.88
- Reevaluation due to failure during previous evaluation: \$0.50 increase from \$504.65 to \$505.15.

**Body Art Facility License Fees**

As stipulated under **MCL 333.13104**, the following adjustments should be made effective October 1, 2019 to the fees:

- Annual license fee increases \$0.55 increase from \$547.15 to \$547.70
- Temporary license fee increases \$0.16 increase from \$164.13 to \$164.29
- Additional late fee increases \$0.27 increase from \$273.58 to \$273.85
- Duplicate license fee increases \$0.05 increase from \$54.70 to \$54.75.
