SUBJECT: Public Health Code Fees Annual Adjustments for Change in Detroit CPI

Three sections of the Public Health Code require for fee changes based on amounts determined by the State Treasurer to reflect annual percent changes in the Detroit CPI. [The sections are: 333.5431(4), 333.13306(4), and 333.13522(8)].

The percentage change from June 2013 to June 2014 in the Detroit All-Items CPI-U is 1.3 percent.

Newborn Screening Fee

On October 1, 2013, the newborn screening fee was increased by \$3.24 to reflect the 3.3 percent increase in the Detroit CPI between June 2012 and June 2013. The fee was also increased by an additional \$5.45 as recommended by the Newborn Screening Quality Assurance Advisory Committee and approved by the legislature to cover the net cost of new screening requirements. Consequently, the newborn screening fee was increased \$8.69 from \$98.08 to \$106.77. To reflect the 1.3 percent increase in the Detroit CPI between June 2013 and June 2014, the newborn screening fee may be increased by no more than \$1.39 from \$106.77 to \$108.16 on October 1, 2014. Please note that the newborn screening fee may be increased further as recommended by the Newborn Screening Quality Assurance Advisory Committee and approved by the legislature to cover the cost of new screening requirements.

Dry Cleaning License Fees

As stipulated in **MCL 333.5431(4)**, the newborn screening fee for existing conditions covered and testing procedures covered may increase no more than \$1.39 from \$106.77 to \$108.16 on October 1, 2014. In addition, as provided under MCL 333.5430, the fee may also be adjusted to account for changes in conditions covered and screening procedures as recommended by the newborn screening quality assurance advisory committee subject to the approval of the Department of Community Health and legislature.

As stipulated under **MCL 333.13306**, dry cleaning management establishment fees shall increase for license year 2015 as follows:

- Initial application and annual license fee base fee increases \$2.15 from \$165.57 to \$167.72.
- Poundage fee increases \$0.06 from \$4.56 to \$4.62.

License Fees for Radioactive Materials and Devices

As stipulated under **MCL 333.13522**, the following adjustments should be made effective October 1, 2014 to the fees:

- Nondental, nonveterinary x-ray tube:
Per tube fee: \$1.61 increase from \$124.03 to \$125.64
- Dental or veterinary x-ray tube
First tube fee: \$0.97 increase from \$74.39 to \$75.36
Each additional tube fee \$0.54 increase from \$41.26 to \$41.80

In connection with mammography authorization (per radiation machine)

- Inspection fee: \$2.15 increase from \$165.41 to \$167.56
- Reinspection for re-instatement: \$2.15 increase from \$165.41 to \$167.56
- Evaluation for compliance: \$14.45 increase from \$1,111.71 to \$1,126.16
- Reevaluation due to failure during previous evaluation:
\$6.19 increase from \$476.37 to \$482.56
