The Receivership Transition Advisory Board for the City of Ecorse has recommended that the city's receivership status under Public Act 436 of 2012 be terminated. The Governor has delegated to me the authority to make this determination, under Section 9(8) of the Act.

In reviewing the City of Ecorse's achievements, it is clear the City has made significant progress operating under the Receivership Transition Advisory Board's (the Board) statutory oversight. Moreover, the city's new management team is poised to help move the City of Ecorse forward in a sustainable fashion.

Consequently, in accordance with Section 9(7), I hereby remove the City of Ecorse from receivership. Any outstanding technical requirements of Section 22(4) of the Act are waived. This action also dissolves the Board for the City of Ecorse, the members of which are greatly appreciated for their service.

This is a significant and well-deserved day in the city's proud history. I extend my congratulations to the City of Ecorse and look forward to an ongoing relationship with the city as it continues on the path of financial stability and success.
