#### **MINUTES**

#### I. Call to Order

Chair Michael Wrobel called the meeting to order at 4:05p.m.

One RTAB member participated via phone as provided in Article IV, Section 5 of Board Resolution 2016-2. A quorum was present.

#### **B.** Approval of Minutes

Motion by Mr. Schrier to approve the draft minutes of the October 29, 2018 meeting as presented. Motion moved and seconded by Mr. Todd. The RTAB approved the minutes.

#### III. New Business

#### A. News and Updates

Chair Wrobel provided a brief update on items brought up in public comment for the previous meeting. Certified teachers for the System include 7/12 teachers at Edgewood, 6/16 at Martin Luther King, 4/7 at the middle school, and 10/12 at the high school. Student count is down for the System; a December budget amendment is anticipated.

#### **B.** Monthly Reports

#### i. Liabilities Report

Mr. Lewis reported interest payments were made on the 2016 refunding bonds. Payments on the emergency loans will occur in December.

#### ii. Cash Flow Projections

Mr. Lewis reported the \$140k in taxes due back to the city resulting from tax corrections are not included in the beginning balance of the report. Next month is projected to be the tightest of the year.

No tax revenues have been received as of the report date. Mr. Lewis reported he intends to call the City after the holiday for an update.

Chair Wrobel asked whether there are any concerns with emergency loan payments coming up. Mr. Lewis reported that despite the \$140k being taken out of the cash flow projection, it remains in the bank account while the City decides how to handle the amount.

#### iii. Comparison of Budgeted Revenue and Expenditure to Actual

Mr. Lewis reported the FY18 audit was completed with no findings and an ending general fund balance of \$29,385. Some FID edits were required with a prior year adjustment being made.

Chair Wrobel asked about the Land and Building Repairs/Maintenance expenditure line. Mr. Lewis noted that the district expects to save some money this year due to the maintenance position being absent.

Attached, please find the Muskegon Heights Public Schools 2018/19 Budget to Actual Revenue and Expenditure Report, Cash Flow Statement, and Liabilities Report for your review.

#### **Budget to Actual Revenue and Expenditure Report**

Attached you will find the budget to actual report for 2018/19 as of December 11, 2018.

We have finally received operating tax disbursements for the current fiscal year (\$379K). I have also talked briefly with the city finance director and inquired about the \$140K adjustment to operating taxes from last year, but they have yet to make a determination on how to address it. We may be a few months off from finalizing that figure.

Expenses continue to be incurred at expected levels for this time of year. We will have two sizeable outgoing transfers for December. One for interest on the emergency loans and the other for the district QZAB bond. The district sees no issue in meeting these obligations.

#### **Cash Flow Statement**

Cash flow continues to remain stable for the coming year. As mentioned in the previous section, we will have fairly substantial outflows this month, but also have sufficient cash on hand to meet these requirements

#### Liabilities Report

There are no changes to the district's outstanding liabilities to report at this time.

The Board of Directors of the Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System ("System Board") is requesting assistance from the Receivership Transition Advisory Board ("RTAB") in order to enable the System Board to properly fulfill its governance responsibilities.

The System Board is specifically requesting the RTAB appoint a member to the System Board. It is our understanding that pursuant to Order 2016-8, issued by Steven M. Schiller, the RTAB is authorized to take action to appoint a member to the System Board, "If the District Board and System Board are unable to agree on a subsequent System Board nominee for appointment...then the Advisory Board shall appoint the subsequent System Board member."

Based on the following facts and the recent tenor of District Board members, it is the System Board's position that "the District Board and the System Board are unable to agree."

- The System Board nominated Ms. Carmella Ealom on June 18, 2018 for reappointment in advance of her term ending July 9, 2018. Ms. Ealom had served the System Board well. She is an active member of the community and served since the inception of the Muskegon Heights Public School Academy System.
- Rather than accept and act on the System Board's nomination of Ms. Ealom, the District Board met on July 3, 2018 and voted to reject the reappointment of Ms. Ealom.
- On October 15, 2018, System Board member, Kathy Moore unexpectedly resigned, resulting in only three board members remaining on the System Board. Ms. Moore's term was set to expire March 17, 2019.
- On November 19, 2018, the System Board approved two nominees, Mr. Christopher Dean and Ms. Celestine Parker, to the District Board for consideration and appointment.
- The District Board has not acted on these nominees and has communicated via a letter from their attorney dated November 30, 2018, that they are not planning to act on these nominations and that they have cancelled their December Board meeting.
- Additionally, the letter stated that the District Board does not intend to act on these
  appointments until the proposed contract amendment presented by the State of Michigan has
  been resolved.
- While you have previously seen the nomination of Mr. Dean, it may be helpful to have some background on Ms. Celestine Parker (no relation to current System Board member Stephen

Parker). Ms. Parker is a Muskegon Heights community member and brings a strong educational perspective to the System Board having formerly served as a teacher, school and central office administrator for the Muskegon Heights Public School District.

With the District Board failing to take action to appoint any of the three nominees properly proposed by the System Board, the System Board is now only one board member away from not having enough members to form a quorum and properly govern the System.

Thus, we feel we have no alternative but to request the RTAB use its authority to bring the System Board back to its full five (5) member capacity by appointing Mr. Dean and Ms. Parker to serve on the System Board at your meeting scheduled for December 19, 2018.
