

State Tax Commission Michigan Advanced Assessing Officer Introduction to Appraisal Statistics Self-Paced Course Student Registration

The State Tax Commission is offering the Michigan Advanced Assessing Officer (MAAO) Introduction to Appraisal Statistics Self-Paced Course as an online/lecture hybrid. Individuals must hold MCAO certification for one year prior to beginning the STC online/lecture hybrid program or the Self-Paced courses. Students must first take Principles of Appraising, then Statistics and then Basic Income before any other courses.

The course begins online on November 9, 2025. Online work will continue until January 9, 2026, with the classroom session from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, January 10, 2026, at the Okemos Best Western, Stadium Room. Information on accessing the online classroom will be sent the week of October 27, 2025. The Exam for this course is Monday, January 12, 2026, at the Okemos Best Western, Stadium Room.

Students who attend the course and qualify to sit for the exam, will be issued a course credit and 16 hours of assessor continuing education credit for the current assessor renewal cycle. However, assessing officers will still need to complete the 2026 State Tax Commission Updates Course (either in-person or through the STC Online Education Portal) in order to recertify for 2027. Students may register for the course by sending a completed registration form to the STC no later than October 17, 2025. Late registration, registration at the door and auditing of the MAAO course is not allowed.
